Grammatical areas: general knowledge of German, grammar basics and all the language skills practiced are revised in many exercises and activities which stabilize and practice their use in various situations (morphology (lexical categories / word classes / lexical classes / parts of speech; word formation) and syntax (sentence types, phrases, word order), tenses, „Passiversatzformen“, Infinitive Construct); grammatical commonalities and differences in in both languages (Serbian and German); practical exercises (substitution, transformation, addition, answer the questions, question etc.); at the lexical level: (general and specific vocabulary (study, internship, profession).
